Why tea?

Because when busy people have a cup of tea, they stop and think for a moment...

Step 1. Find a group of young people – any age, any ability

- Primary school
- Secondary school
- Youth groups
- Individual initiative



Step 2. Talk about the issues that matter to you and the world...

... then decide which one your group thinks is the most important



Step 3. Decide your message

What does your group want to say about the world, to the world?



Step 4. Identify your audience

Who do you want to hear your message? – someone local, national, international...?

Who do you think would drink your tea?

Step 5. Buy your tea and design a package for your message



Try to be...

- *Creative*
- *Original*
- *Interesting*



Step 6. Deliver your message

Think of an unusual way to send your gift...

“T - Day”!



Step 7. Tell your story

Send us a report about your project, e.g.

- *Video (2 minutes)*
- *Photo / picture report*
- *Written report*

- *Local TV*
- *Newspapers*
